

Reimbursement of expenses for international Students from South-East-Europe

As of November 2018

§36 par. 6 Legal Regulations for Academic Affairs of the TU Graz statute:

Degree students of nationalities Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Kosovo, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Serbia, Turkey, Ukraine and Belarus, during their bachelor's, master's or doctoral degree programme at Graz University of Technology with appropriate study progress can have their tuition fee reimbursed on application, with the implementing provisions to be published in the university gazette.

The tuition fee of € 726.72 which was paid for the preceding semester will be refunded provided that the **following conditions** have been fulfilled:

- 1.) Proof of performance:** Proof of at least 8 semester hours of course examinations relevant to the study programme and/ or 12 ECTS credits within one semester OR confirmation of good progress in writing a thesis (diploma or master's thesis max. 2 semesters; doctoral thesis max. 6 semesters in the case of two-year doctoral programmes, and max. 8 semesters in the case of three-year doctoral programmes.)
Examination period: Respectively within the semester according to the division of the academic year as specified by the Senate

- 2.) Anticipated length of study programme + "tolerance semester" of the study programme to which they were first admitted and registered not exceeded:**

In the case of bachelor's/master's/doctoral study programmes:
anticipated length of study programme + 2 tolerance semesters

- 3.) Study programme exclusively offered at Graz University of Technology, excluding co-registrations as part of the combined study programme in Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering at Graz University of Music and Performing Arts, study programmes as part of the NAWI Graz cooperation project and inter-university study programmes (e.g. teacher training programmes).**

The reimbursement may only be applied for by students who, having received a notice of payment, paid a tuition fee of € 726,72 and who have fulfilled all the above mentioned criteria.

Applications for reimbursement for the summer semester can be made from the 15th May until latest 30th September, and applications for reimbursement for the winter semester from 15th December until latest 31st March. Applications are to be made at the Registration Office of TU Graz.

There is no legal right for the reimbursement to be granted.
