to take probably from 2017/09/01. The position is done in one according to §99 UG for 5 years of limited employer-employee relationship to the Graz University of Technology. This professorship is furnished within the scope of an endowment, carried by members from pro:Holz, to the Styria and FHP (forest wood paper). The allocation of the professorship occurs to the institute of Architecture Technology of the Faculty for Architecture.

An academically stated personality which represents the topic of the lasting construction in the context of qualitatively high-quality architecture in the timber-frame construction in research and apprenticeship is searched. The construction-cultural dimension of the subject architecture and timberframe construction should be provided the student by integration of sound practical and very international experiences and a consciousness for responsible, lasting construction be promoted. This includes the principles of the design in the timber-frame construction, the development of detailed aspects of education, the technical-formative potentials in the inside removal and the use of new material components. The application innovative draught methods, technologies and production methods in the apprenticeship should serve at the same time plumbing new research fields.

The scientific development of the field of architecture and timber-frame construction and the apprenticeship on bachelor is incumbent upon the professorship, as well as on master and doctorate level. Besides, it is wished that new cooperations with the economy are built up and are maintained. An active cooperation in all interests of the faculty is expected.

To be able to represent internationally the field, good knowledge of English is demanded in word and writing. Provided that German knowledge is given not anyway, the readiness is assumed for learning of the German.

Relocation of residence to the Graz area is mandatory.

Employment requirements:

- A completed university education in Austria or equivalent from abroad, relevant to the subject.
- An outstanding academic qualification in research for the subject applied for.
- Teaching experience and exceptional didactic skills.
- Competence in leadership.
- Experience abroad specific to the subject.
- Relevant subject-specific practice outside the university setting
