"Everyone loves bricks - the rough and the smooth, the soft and the hard, the red and the yellow, and even when they are factory-made. The latter is especially important, because the brick is always factory, even if hand painted. And it is never industrial, on the other hand, even if it is made with the most modern industrial production methods. It remains, as it were, in perpetual youth, halfway between the potter's craft and the cement industry. This halfwayness is the secret of brick. Like everything ceramic, it comes from far away." (Hoffmann-Axthelm, Dieter: The Brick: A Fascination and Its Object, Archplus 84).
