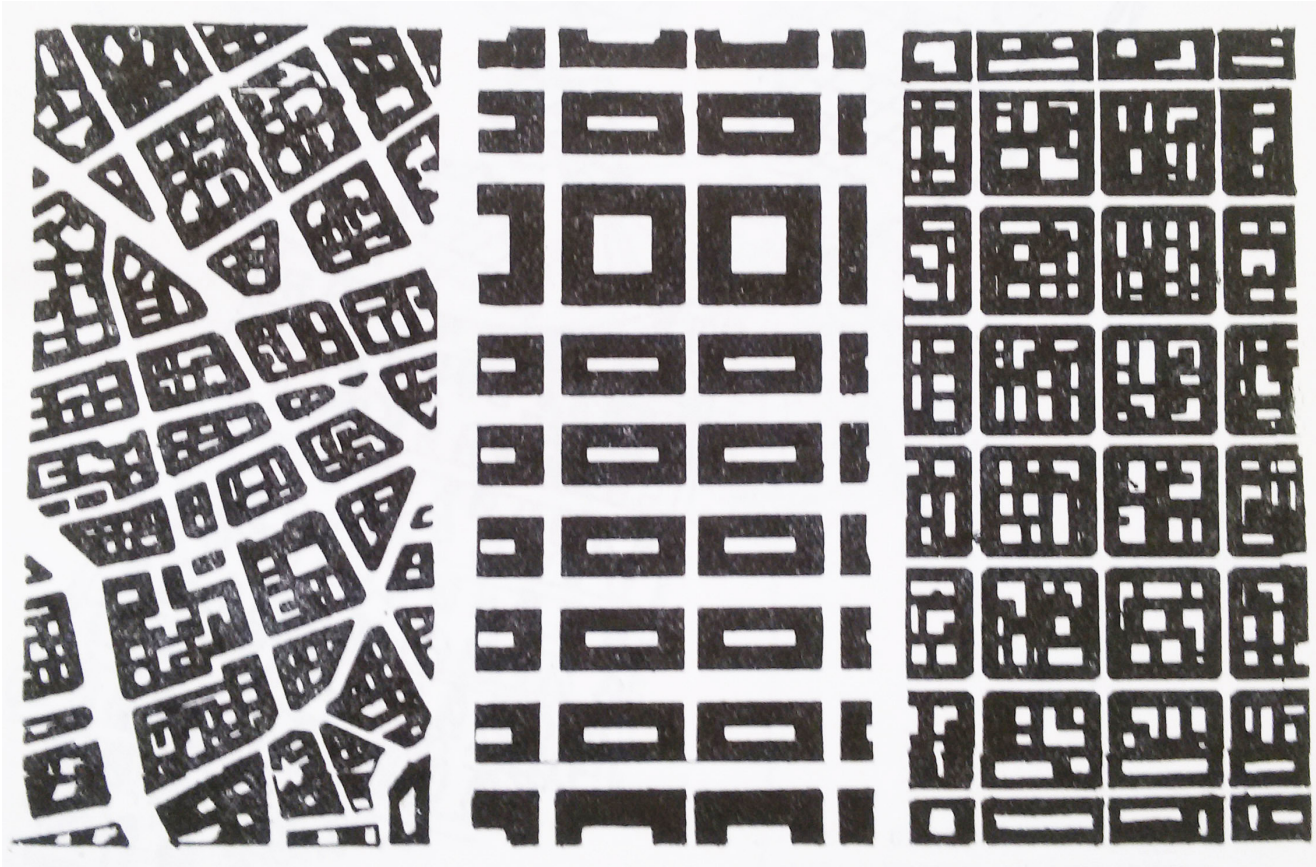

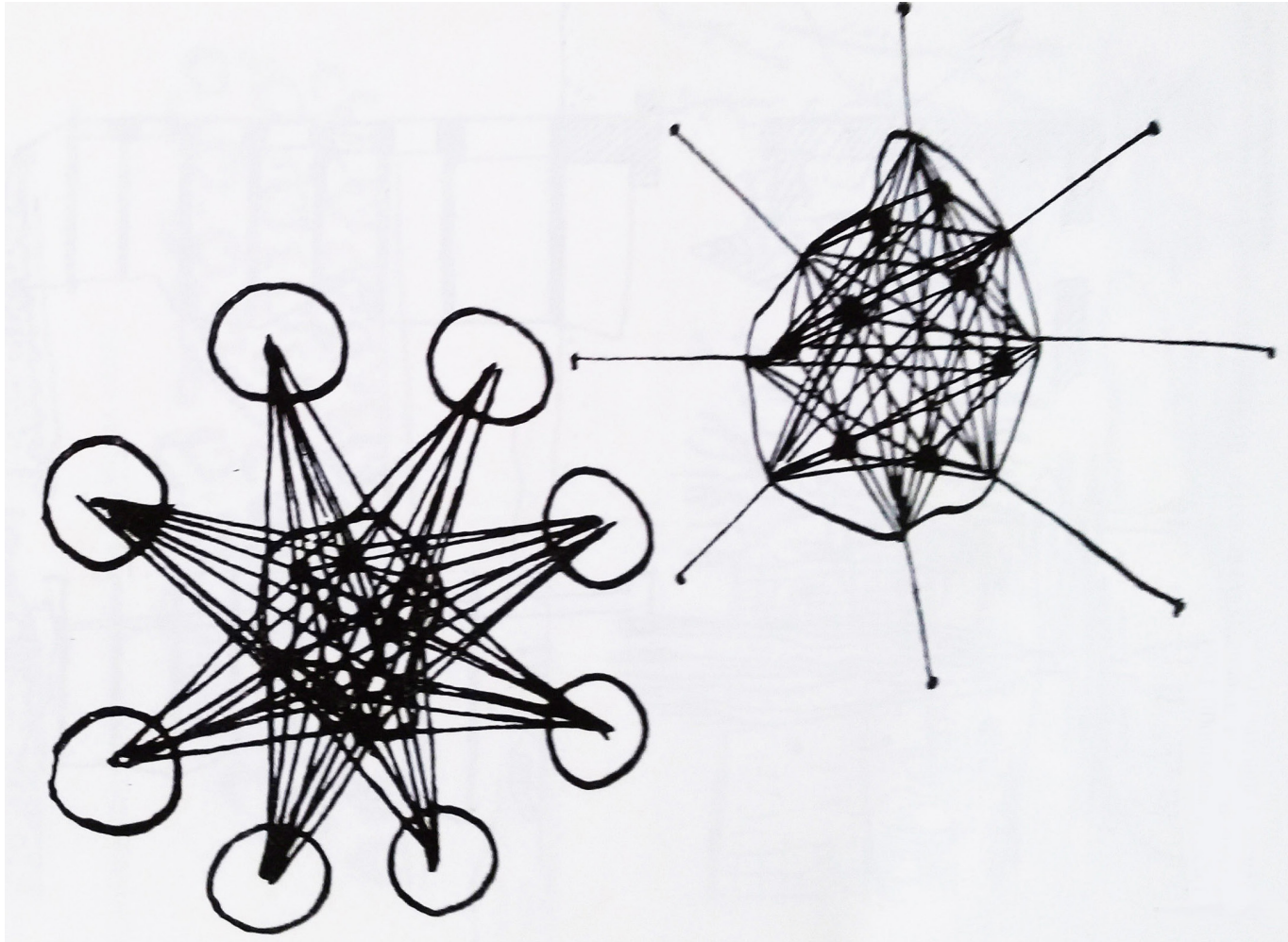


Le Corbusier – The three settlement typologies

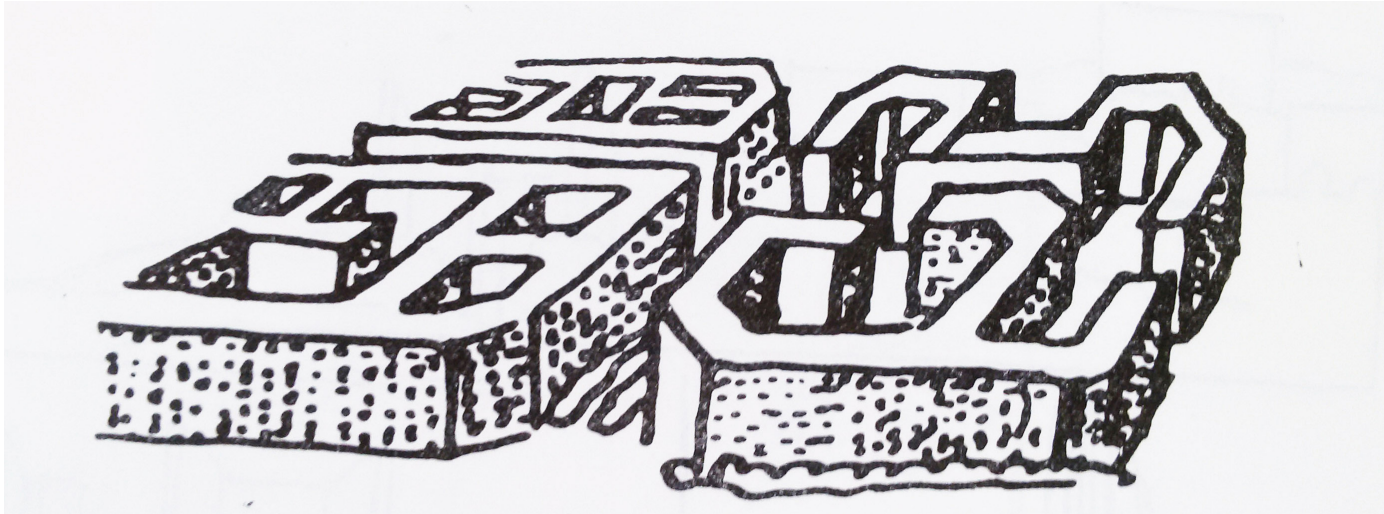

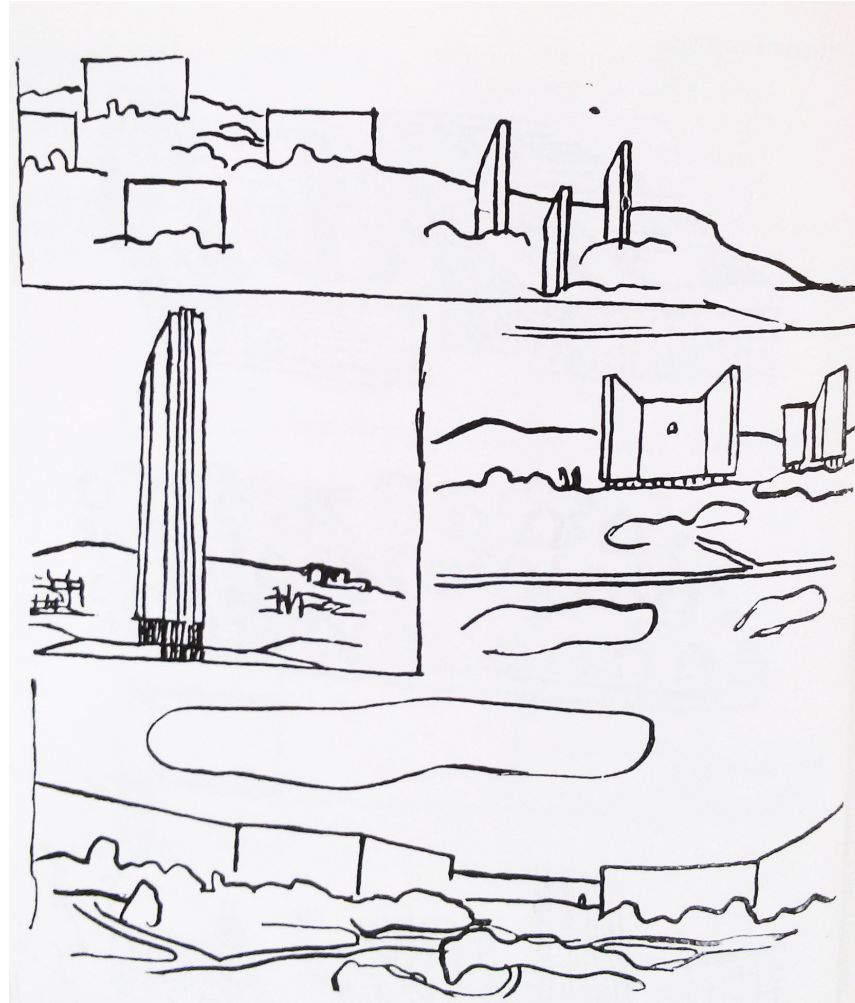

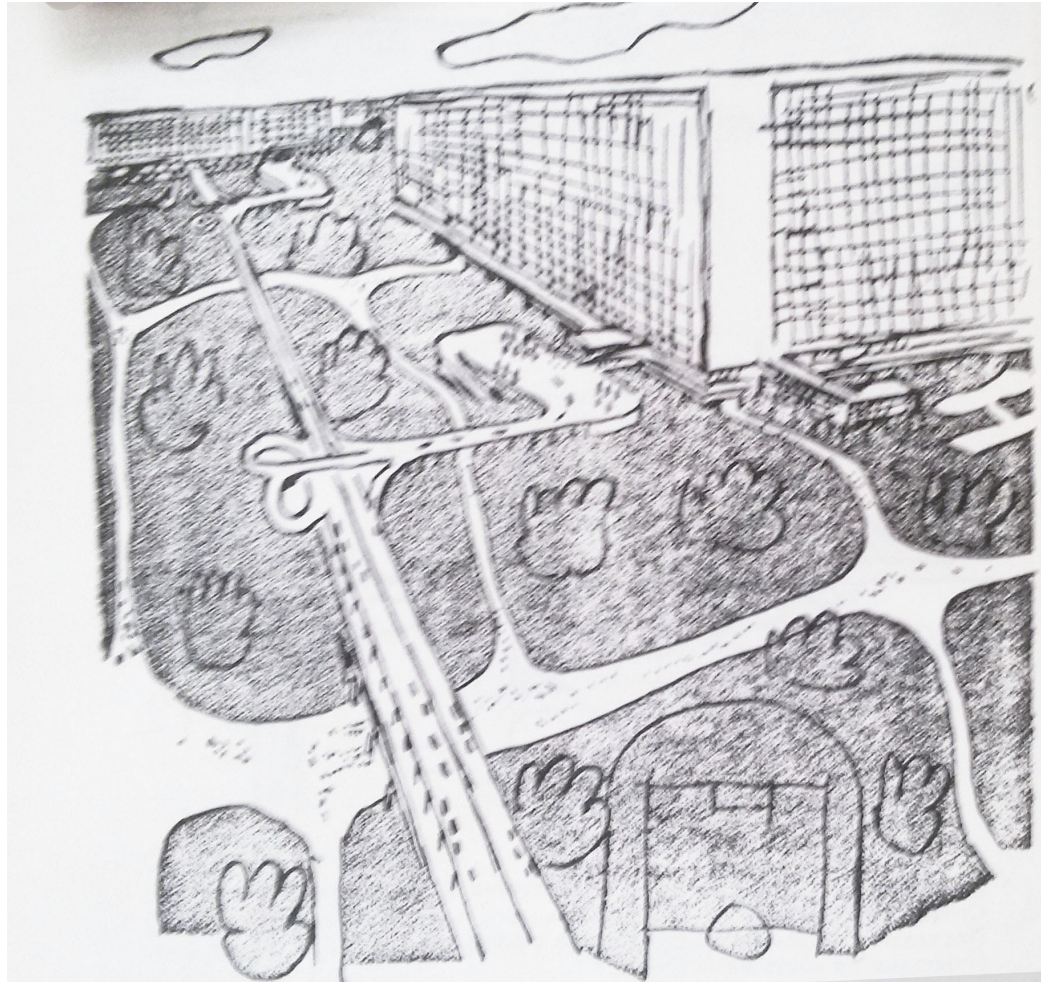

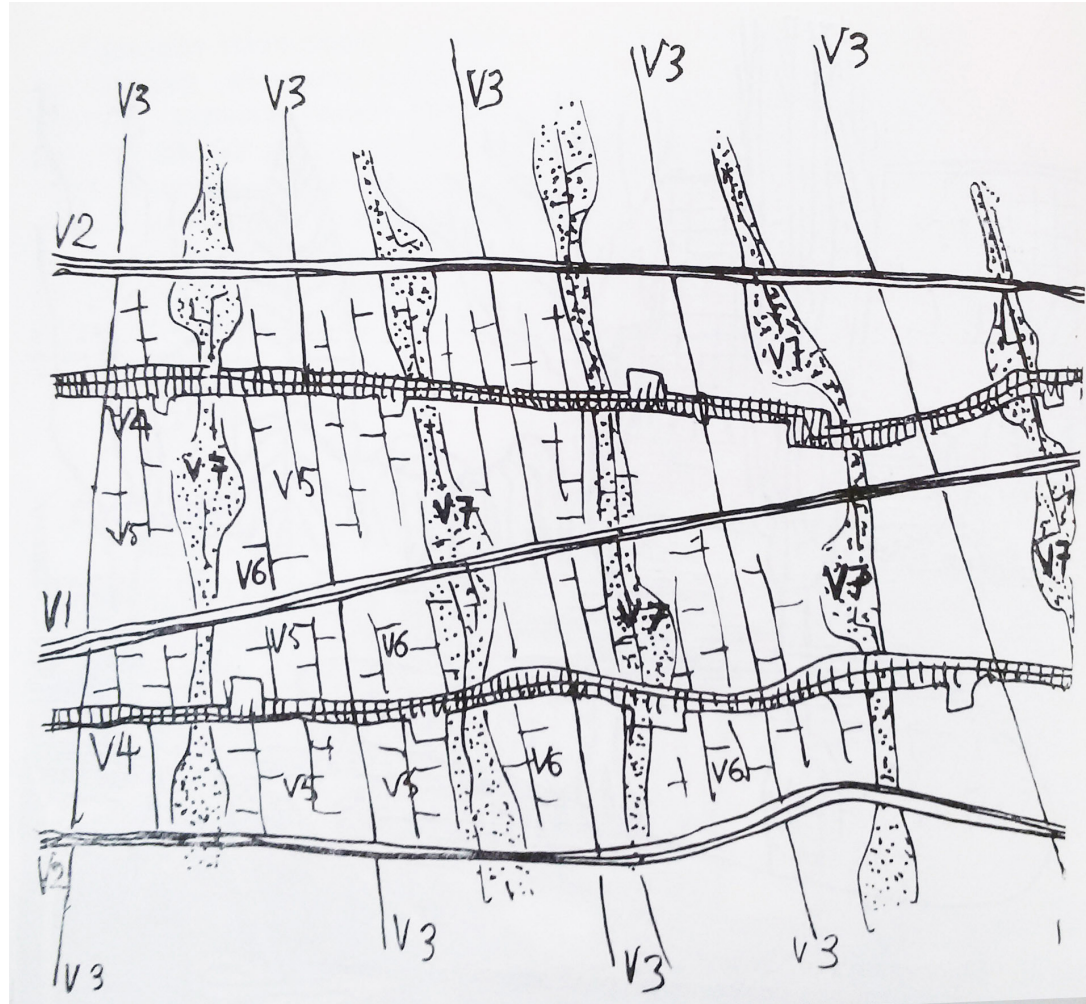

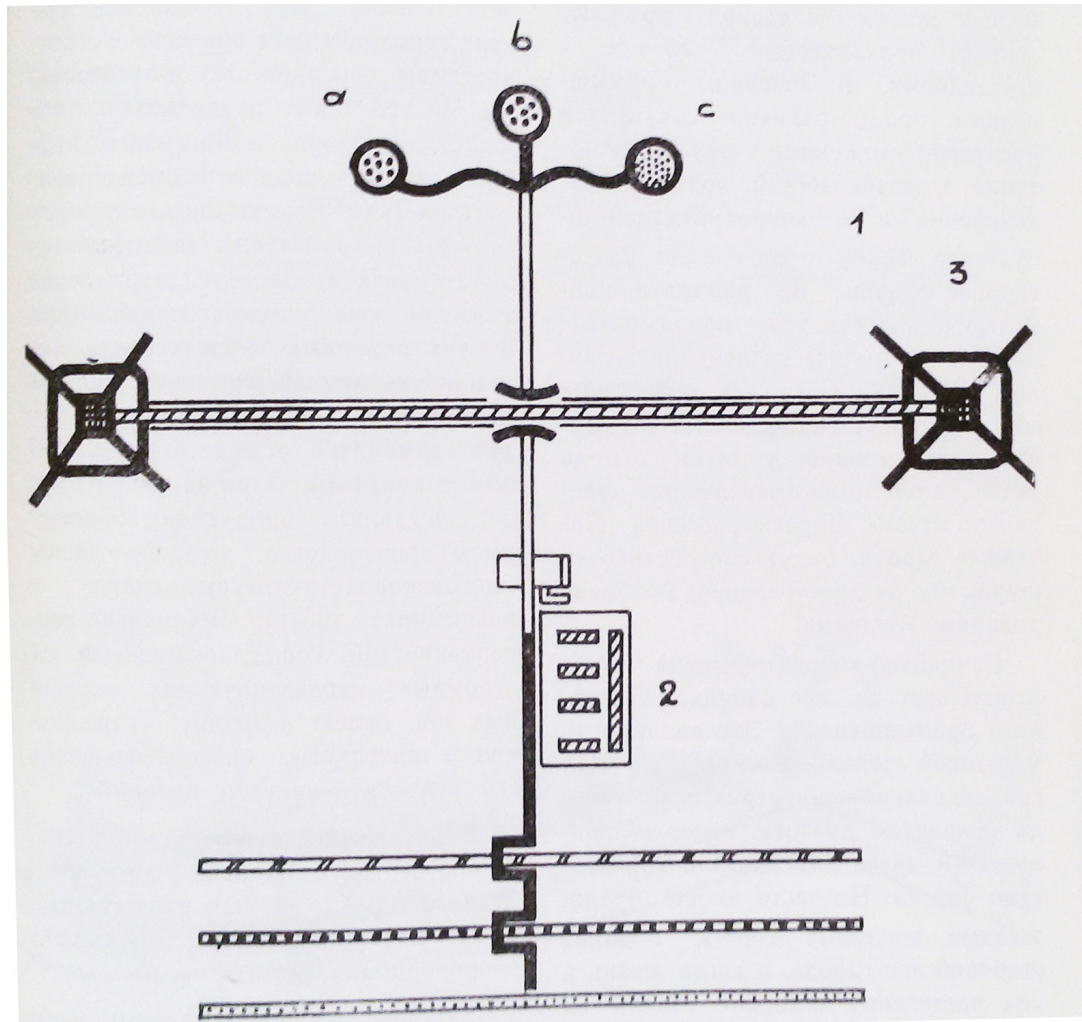

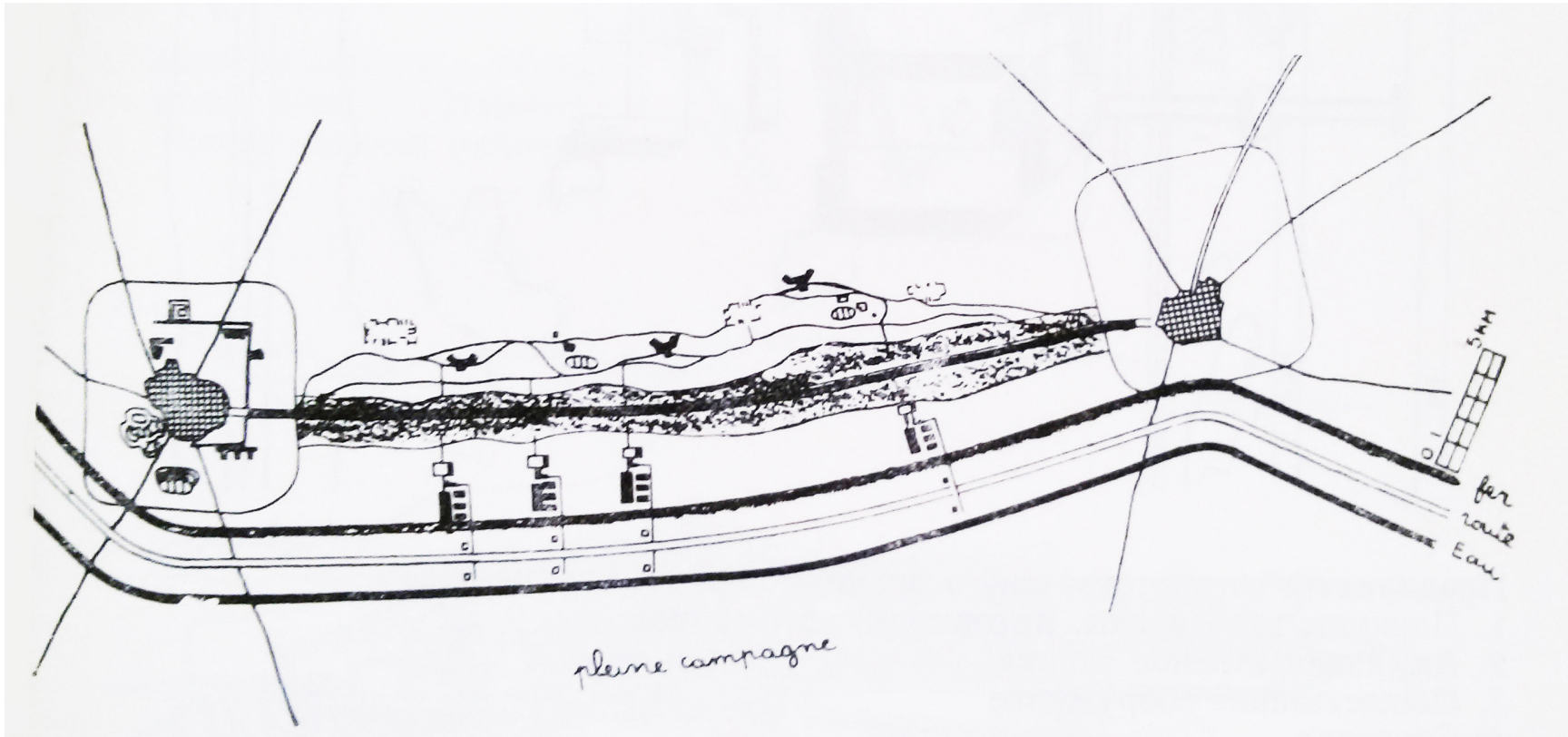

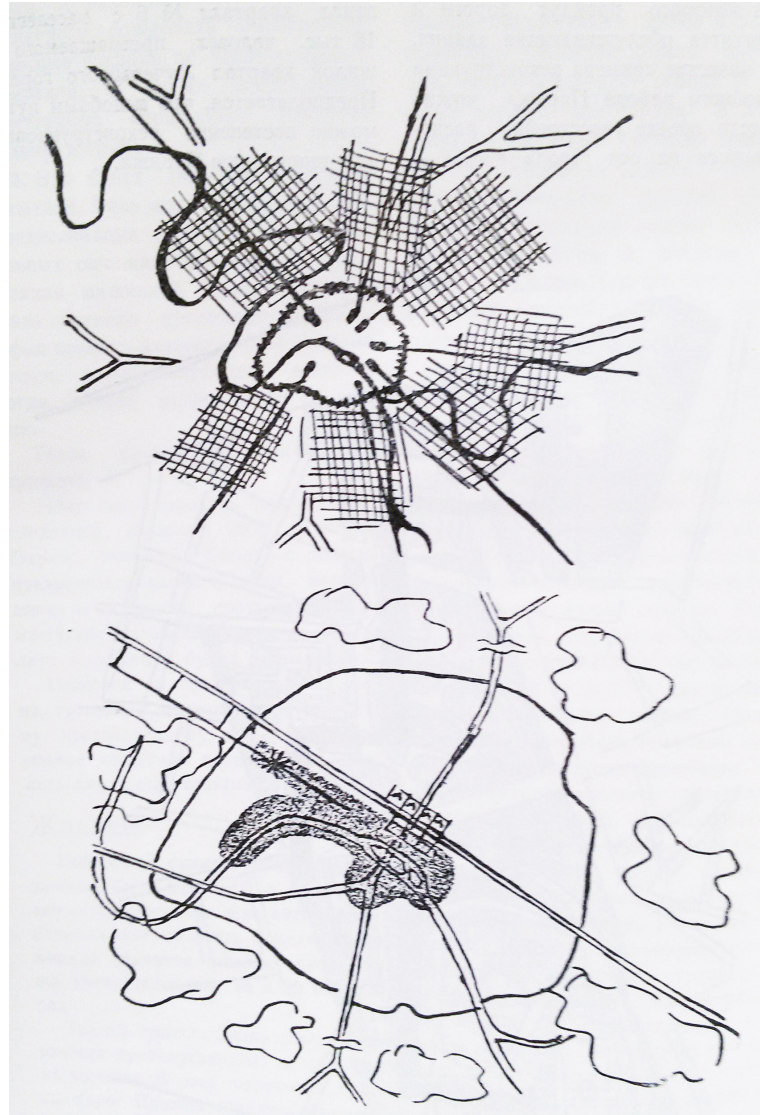


Proposal for the modern region:

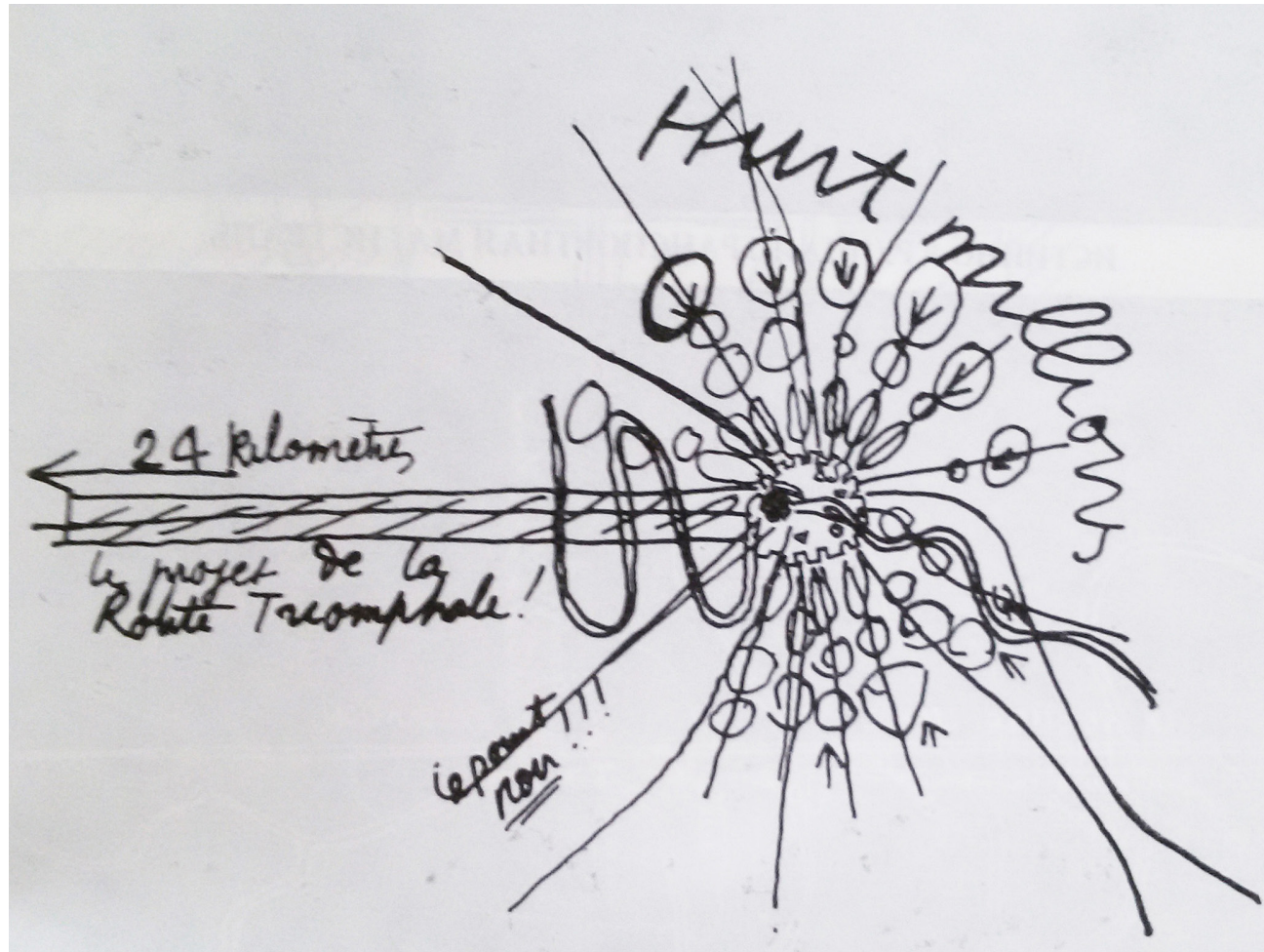

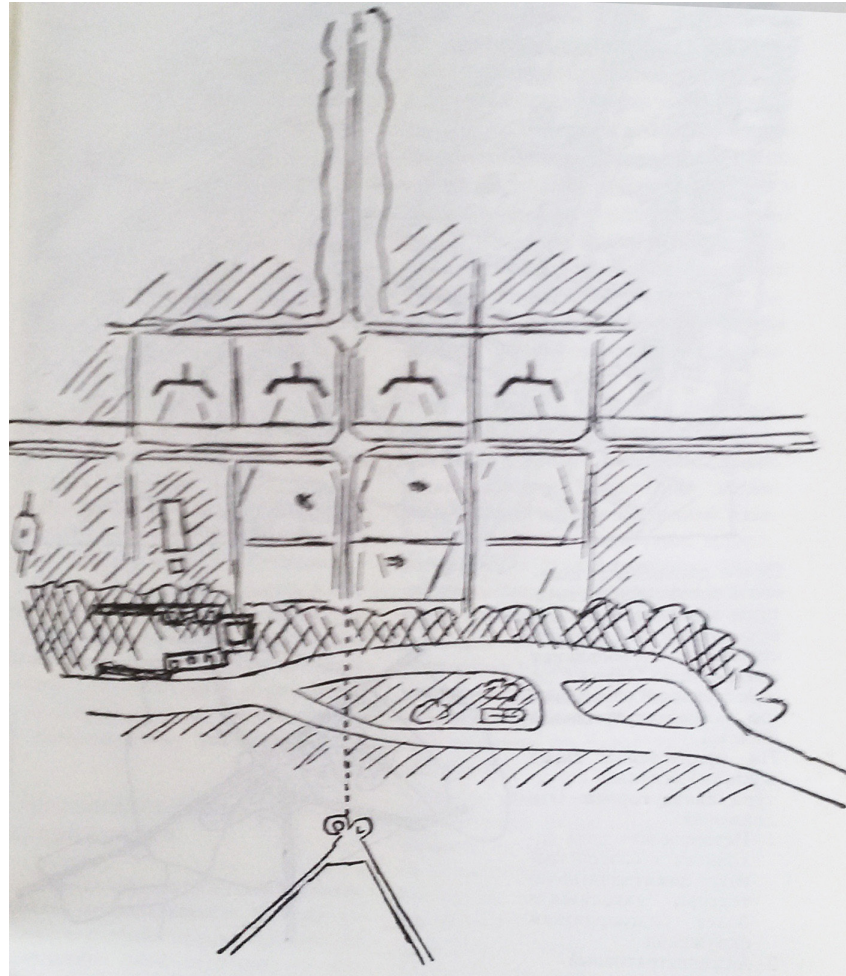

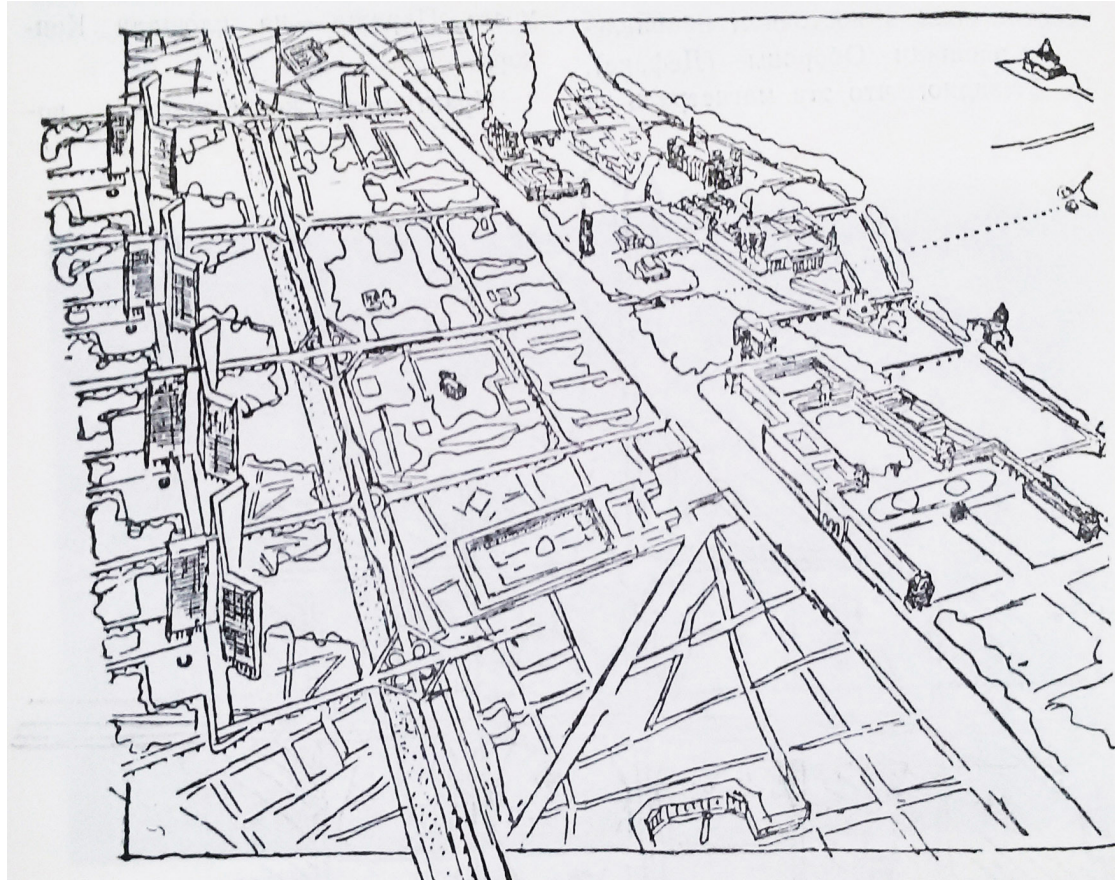
