These exams consist of two parts:

• Multiple Choice Questions (part 1):

Only completely correct answers will be considered as correct and receive points. Questions that are only partially correct do not give points.

Open Questions (part 2):

The answers to the exam questions should be comprehensible and well argued. Keep your answers brief and as precise as possible. Note that no points can be awarded for illegible answers and answers that are not in the language of the exam. The quantity of the answers does not lead to a gain of points.

The two parts of the exam <u>do not</u> have to be positive individually in order to receive a positive grade on the exam overall. It is not possible to credit positively completed parts to the next examination attempt.

The written exam will be assessed within a maximum of four weeks after the exam date. The exam inspection takes place shortly after the announcement of the results.

There will be no additional oral exams to improve the grade of the written exam.
