

MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIP for the academic year 2019/20 Faculty of Mathematics, Physics and Geodesy

According to § 57 Studienförderungsgesetz (StudFG), merit-based scholarships serve the recognition of excellent academic achievements. Austrian citizens or equivalent foreigners and stateless persons can be supported according to § 4 StudFG.

A merit-based scholarship may not be below € 750.00 and may not exceed € 1,500.00.

According to § 61 (3) StudFG, the scholarship will be awarded by the university body responsible for study law matters and depends on the number of scholarship applicants.

There is no legal entitlement to the grant.

A) Requirements according to § 60 (1) StudFG for the award are:

- 1. Compliance with the entitlement period (§ 18 StudFG) of the relevant period of study (this is the legally defined period of study plus one additional semester), taking into account any important reasons (§ 19 StudFG) e.g. pregnancy, military service, etc.
- A grade point average of at most 2.0*) for all examinations, courses and thesis.
- 3. Compliance with the submission requirements: Submission of the documents referred to in section B).
- *) Minimum requirement for the consideration of the selection process.

B) The applicant must also submit:

- <u>Data sheet</u> (for Bachelor-, Master- and PhD students). 1.
- Transcript of records from 01.10.2018 to 30.09.2019.
- 3. Confirmation of other activities (e.g. student assistant, posters, author, ...).
