# MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP for the academic year 2021/22



## of the Faculty of Architecture

According to § 57 Studienförderungsgesetz (StudFG) Student Support Act, merit-based scholarship grants are intended to reward students for outstanding academic achievement in a regular degree program. The scholarship can be awarded to Austrian citizens or applicants considered as equivalent to Austrian citizens according to § 4 StudFG.

The degree programme must have been successfully completed in the same academic year in which the application is submitted.

Merit-based scholarship grants may not be below  $\notin$  750 or exceed  $\notin$  1.500. According to § 61 (3) StudFG the Department of Academic Affairs awards the grant. The award of grants depends on the number of applicants. There is no automatic entitlement to a grant.

### A Requirements according to § 60 StudFG:

- 1. Compliance with the entitlement period (§18 StudFG), accounting for any extensions due to reasonable cause (§19 StudFG).
- 2. A grade point average of 2.0 for all courses to be considered for the scholarship\*).
- 3. Compliance with the submission requirements: information as explained in section B.

\*) This is the minimum requirement to be considered and entered into the selection process.

### **<u>B</u>** The applicant must additionally submit:

- 1. Data sheet (for Bachelor, Master and PhD students) https://lampx.tugraz.at/~tcvb/ARCH/leistungsstipendium\_en/
- A Portfolio including: <u>Bachelor Students:</u> Design 1/2/3/4, Design of specialised topics, Workshop 3 or the equivalents from the Diploma course <u>Master Students:</u> Design Studios I/II/III and the Master thesis or the equivalents from the Diploma course <u>Doctorate Students:</u> A thesis graded with a 2.0 or better.

Please note the regulatory requirements for BSc and MSc:

- Portfolios can contain a maximum of 3 pieces of work.
- All presentation techniques are allowed.
- Plans and maps with a maximum size of A3.
- Please do not deliver actual models, only pictures of your models.
- Loose collections of papers are only accepted if each sheet is clearly labelled.
