



- Development of a **catalogue of options** on how the SDGs might be achieved in Austria
- Address **SDGs in universities** in research, teaching, life-long learning, responsible science and in university management
- Identify **research needs** and develop research projects across universities
- Create added value through cooperation and **new combinations of knowledge**
- Improve **interdisciplinary co-operation** within and between universities
- **Interaction with stakeholders** from politics, administration, economy and civil society
- Attempt at **interaction** with **socially vulnerable groups**
- **Build capacity** amongst researchers, teachers and students regarding the issues addressed by the SDGs

Coordination of activities related to one SDG, gathering of inputs of the contributing universities.


What is a

Approach


- 155.000 publications and 17.000 projects of 15 universities

Research question


How are publications and projects related to the SDGs?

- Support universities in finding their focus areas within UniNetZ




SDG Options Systemic Approach



Task
Identification and testing of interdependencies between options

Goal
Holistic identification of synergies and trade-offs.

Method: Workshop, Flichart



Method: iMODELER

1. Setting the structure for collaborative work between participating institutions
2. Identification of research strengths – solid expertise available to work on SDGs
3. First report: methodological approaches in developing measures to achieve SDGs incl. examples of options
4. Filling the gaps
 - Extension of expertise involving further stakeholders and partners
 - Development of appropriate methods and communication formats
5. SDG options – identification of synergies and trade-offs– systemic approach
