What is ecoinvent?



- A Swiss not-for-profit association that supports life-cycle-based approaches world-wide through access to data
 - Financed through licensing and project income
- Publishes the ecoinvent database Life Cycle Inventory data on many thousands of products and services
- ecoinvent is a data publisher
- Further mission-related activities:
 - Capacity building and knowledge transfer on LCI data management and handling

Who uses the ecoinvent database?



- More than 7'000 licences of the ecoinvent database representing many tens
 of thousands of users from over 80 countries
- Primary users are consultants, industry, researchers, policy makers
 - 70% of the licence revenues comes from the commercial and policy users while
 30% of comes from academic users
- Most common use is Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) and Carbon Footprinting
 - Also used in EPDs (e.g. EN 15804), PEF, Circular Economy efforts, water footprints, resource criticality, Social LCA, and other sustainability assessments
 - Foundation or supporting data for many private and public tools and systems

What does the database contain?



- ecoinvent is a background database which contains average data on different materials and services
- e.g. energy, basic materials, agriculture, transport, machinery, ...
- Focus on consistency, reliability and transparency



- More than 17000 datasets for around 3200 products
- Datasets for up to 140 countries
- A new release every year
