CEEPUS – Central European Exchange Programme for University Studies

CEEPUS is a transnational, central European university network, consisting of various subject-specific networks. Member states: Albania, Austria, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, North Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland, Rumania, Serbia, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Czech Republic and the Kosovo: University of Prishtina, University Prizren, University Peja.

Scholarship

- Comprehensive grant scholarships covered by the host country
- Monthly mobility allowance covered by funds of the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research with respect to stays abroad exceeding 2 months
- Travel grants funded by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research

Mobility opportunities

- Student: for undergraduates there is a minimum stay of 3 months to max.
 10 months
- Student Short term: 1-2 months to write a bachelor's, master's or doctorate thesis
- Summer schools: 6-20 days, summer school organized by the host institution
- Student mobility Short term excursion: 3-10 days, excursion organized by the home or host institution

- Successful completion of 2 semesters as a degree student at an Austrian university or University of Applied Sciences
- Citizen of a CEEPUS country
- No nomination for a stay abroad as part of another mobility programme in the same time period

Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies

Erasmus+ enables mobility of students at higher education institutions. Members: EU-countries, Iceland, Liechtenstein, North Macedonia, Serbia, Norway and Turkey. Partner universities in the UK are listed under the OverSEAs Programme and are no longer associated with Erasmus+. Within the framework of the Erasmus+ programme, students have the opportunity to go abroad for up to 12 months during each study cycle (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate), both in order to study and/or to complete a traineeship.

- Tuition fee waiver at host institution
- Tuition fee waiver at TU Graz (student union fee has to be paid)
- Stipend: approx. € 470 € 520 per month plus additional Distance Band support (depending on the host country)
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a monthly Top-Up of € 250

- Enrolment as a degree student at TU Graz or co-registered as part of a NAWI Graz study programme, the joint degree programme CSS or the Teacher Education Programme for Secondary Schools within the Teacher Education Network South-East
- Students of the study programme in Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering can only apply if TU Graz is the home university.

Erasmus+ Student Traineeships

Erasmus+ enables mobility of students at higher education institutions. Members: EU-countries, Iceland, Liechtenstein, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia and Turkey. Within the framework of the Erasmus+ programme, students have the opportunity to go abroad for up to 12 months during each study cycle (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate), both in order to study and/or to complete a traineeship.

Eligible institutions/companies

Private and public companies/institutions (also higher education institutions) independent of size, legal form and business area.

Excluded are:

- EU institutions and organisations
- organisations that administer EU programmes
- members of the European Parliament
- private persons

Scholarship*

- Tuition fee waiver at TU Graz (student union fee has to be paid)
- Stipend: approx. € 620 € 670 per month, plus additional Distance Band support (depending on the host country)
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a monthly Top-Up of € 250.
- Funding is limited to max. 3 months

Application requirements

Enrolment as a degree student at TU Graz; students who are registered for a NAWI Graz study programme, the joint degree programme CSS, Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering or for the Teacher Education Programme for Secondary Schools within the Teacher Education Network South-East can only apply, if TU Graz is the home university.

ISEP - International Student Exchange Program

The International Student Exchange Program (ISEP) is the biggest international network for student exchange, consisting of more than 350 partner universities in countries all over the world (for European universities, please see Erasmus+ programme). The exchange programme is administrated by the ISEP Global Office in Arlington (VA), USA.

Scholarship

Required payment of programme fee of € 2,500 to TU Graz Included benefits:

- Tuition fee waiver at host institution.
- Tuition fee waiver at TU Graz (student union fee has to be paid)
- Accommodation covered by the host institution
- Monthly stipend from the host institution (meal stipend)
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a special grant for mobilities (€ 250 per month)

- Enrolment as a degree student at TU Graz; students who are registered for a NAWI Graz study programme, the joint degree programme CSS, Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering or for the Teacher Education Programme for Secondary Schools within the Teacher Education Network South-East can only apply if TU Graz is the home university.
- Completion of at least 60 ECTS credits in the field of study which is relevant for their exchange at application deadline
- Good grades
- The majority of ISEP partner universities require a TOEFL or IELTS exam with excellent results; if a student is applying to universities where the language of instruction is not English, comprehensive knowledge of the national language (e.g. Spanish) is required.
- Students are allowed to study abroad with ISEP only once.
- Duration: 1 semester
- No nomination for other mobility programmes in the same time period.

Montclair Scholarship, USA

Within the framework of the town twinning agreement (Städtepartnerschaft) between the cities Graz and Montclair (New Jersey, USA) two students have the opportunity to study abroad for a period of one year. The cities Graz and Montclair have been twin cities for a long time and the student exchange programme is at the core of the town twinning agreement. The city of Graz sends students as ambassadors representing the city of Graz in Montclair. Nominated students have to enrol for a full load of 12 semester hours at the host university (Montclair State University).

Scholarship

- Tuition fee waiver at host institution
- Tuition fee waiver at TU Graz (student union fee has to be paid)
- Student housing and meal cards covered by the twin cities
- Travel allowance
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a special grant for mobilities (€ 250 per month)

- Enrolment as a degree student at TU Graz; students who are registered for a NAWI Graz study programme, the joint degree programme CSS, Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering or for the Teacher Education Programme for Secondary Schools within the Teacher Education Network South-East can only apply, if TU Graz is the home university.
- Students may apply from their 1st semester on.
- Reference to Graz/Austria:
 - Applicants with residence in Graz (for at least 2 years) are preferred
 - Knowledge of the city of Graz and Austrian culture
 - Very good knowledge of German and English
- Duration of stay: 1 academic year
- No nomination for other mobility programmes in the same time period.

Research Abroad

Students who are currently writing their bachelor's, master's or doctorate thesis can apply for a scholarship for academic research at a university, research institute or company worldwide.

Students can receive funding for

a) Bachelor's thesis: 2 weeks up to 2 months b) Master's thesis: 2 weeks up to 4 months c) Doctorate thesis: 2 weeks up to 8 months

Multiple applications are possible.

Students planning a stay in Europe (except Switzerland and Great Britain) for at least 2 months, can apply for the Erasmus+ student traineeships. Students planning a stay shorter than 2 months or outside of Europe (or in Switzerland and Great Britain) may apply for the Research Abroad Scholarship.

Subsidy for Traineeships

Students of TU Graz have the opportunity to receive a grant payment for a traineeship abroad. The traineeship must be relevant for their studies and provide them with practical training. Students can apply for the grant once during each study cycle (Bachelor, Master, Doctorate) from the first semester

Eligible institutions/ companies for receiving a trainee

Private and public companies/ institutions (also higher education institutions) independent of size, legal form and business area are all possible.

Students who are planning a traineeship of at least 2 months in an EU/EEA country, Serbia, North Macedonia or Turkey can apply for an Erasmus+traineeship. Students are not allowed to apply for both grants for the same time period.

Scholarship*

- Traineeships outside of Europe: one time grant of € 300

Summer Schools and Academic Courses Abroad

Students can receive funding for attending summer schools and specialist courses throughout the year.

- Multiple applications are possible; students may receive funding for up to six months in total, but for a minimum of five days and a maximum of four weeks per summer school or course.
- The scholarship cannot be used for the participation in language courses, conferences and meetings.

Scholarship*

- Stipend
- Travel allowance
- Course fee allowance: students are refunded 2/3 of the course costs, up to a maximum of € 1.000
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a special grant for mobilities (€ 250 per month)

- Enrolment as a degree student at TU Graz for at least one year; students who are registered for a NAWI Graz study programme, the joint degree programme CSS, Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering or for the Teacher Education Programme for Secondary Schools within the Teacher Education Network South-East can only apply if TU Graz is the home university.
- Completion of at least 30 ECTS credits in the bachelor's degree programme relevant for the stay abroad, no proof of ECTS credits required for master's and PhD degree programmes
- No nomination for other mobility programmes in the same time period

Joint Courses with International Universities

This programme offers financial support if a part of the course at TU Graz is officially held in cooperation with an international university and together with students from this university. This usually concerns blocked courses, in which one block - lasting between 5 days and three weeks - takes place abroad.

Scholarship

- Stipend (for maximum 15 students)
- Travel allowance
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a special grant for mobilities (€ 250 per month)

- The course has to be held in cooperation with an international university;
 the course can be held in a block module during the stay abroad.
- Funding is only possible for international universities from outside the German-speaking regions. Exception: cooperation with a strategic partner university or at a Unitel partner university in the German-speaking region.
- The stay abroad must be part of a course at TU Graz and also part of a course at the host institution.
- Students from both universities have to work together on projects and achieve predefined goals.
- Students have to be enrolled at TU Graz (main university); students studying any NAWI-programmes, the joint degree programme CSS or Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering can only apply if TU Graz is their main university.

Application procedure

The course lecturer submits an application for funding at the International Office - Welcome Center before the twice-yearly submission deadline.

Students can inform the lecturer about this funding opportunity or inform the International Office about a possible course. The International Office will then contact the lecturer and give more information about this mobility programme.

After the deadline, applications are assessed according to given criteria and a maxiumum of four joint courses per semester selected to receive funding (max. one joint course per institute)

Marshall Plan Scholarship, USA

The Marshall Plan Program is funded by the Austrian Marshall Plan Foundation. It is the Foundation's goal to see more Austrians and Americans participate in exchange programmes, thereby increasing mutual understanding of the host countries. The programme focuses primarily on research in technical sciences and applicants need to be working on their thesis. Applicants will be asked to hand in a research paper after their stay abroad. The minimum duration of stay is three months.

Scholarship

- between € 4,000 and € 10,000
- Students with special needs or chronic illnesses and students with children can apply for a special grant for mobilities (€ 250 per month)

- Enrolment as a degree student at TU Graz for at least two years; students who are registered for a NAWI Graz study programme, the joint degree programme CSS, Electrical Engineering and Audio Engineering or for the Teacher Education Programme for Secondary Schools within the Teacher Education Network South-East can only apply if TU Graz is the home university.

Freemover Programme

TU Graz offers students the possibility of financial support for self-organised study visits. If TU Graz does not have any cooperation agreements with a suitable university or if all places on relevant mobility programmes are taken, students can also go abroad as a Freemover and take coures towards their degree programme at TU Graz. Students take care of the organisation of their stay abroad on their own. There are no restrictions regarding the choice of host university and destination country.

After the acceptance from the host university, students can apply for financial support within the framework of the Freemover Programme at the International Office-Welcome Center of TU Graz. The prerequisite for receiving the scholarship is the achievement of a minimum academic performance of 3 ECTS credits during the stay abroad which must be recognized towards the degree programme at TU Graz after completing the Freemover Programme.

The duration of the stay at the host university can range from 5 weeks to 1 academic year.

Scholarship

- Monthly stipend (the amount depends on the host country)
- Travel allowance
