DID YOU KNOW?

This month we would like to present a central European tradition to you, the *Christkind*.

The *Christkind* is a traditional giver of gifts at Christmas time, mainly in European countries including Germany, Austria, Czech Republic, Liechtenstein, Hungary, Slovakia and Switzerland. The word *Christkind* translates to the child of Christ. Christmas in Austria is celebrated on the eve of December 24th.

Therefore, in Austria we do not have Santa Clause, but we do celebrate bishop Sant Nicholas (*HI. Nikolaus*) on December 6, where *good* children usually receive a bag (*Nikolaussackerl*) containing a small gift, gingerbread, tangerines and nuts.
