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## THE TEACHING ACADEMY

The Teaching Academy's qualification programme is aimed at all TU Graz teaching staff and offers three modules which provide basic training as well as the opportunity to gain further qualifications in higher education didactics based on one's needs and interests. In addition, various consulting services are available to address individual questions.

The completion of each of the three modules – “Basic”, “Advanced” and “Expert” – is awarded with a certificate. The individual workshops within the modules, however, can also be attended independently of the certificate.
