

Features of CAMPUSonline

Student Life Cycle

CAMPUSonline is both an information as well as an administration system, providing all essential features that are relevant throughout the student life cycle for students, lecturers as well as for staff members of centralised and decentralised administration bodies at higher education institutions. The system covers all areas – from the degree programme offer, the application process for prospective students and applicants as well as the collection and management of student data to the organisation of the entire studies (courses, exams, evaluations and theses) to alumni services.

 The initial setup of the Rights Management, personal and user profiles as well as Room and Resource Management serves as the basis for the student life cycle.

- The whole admission process of a higher education institution can be organised using the Application Management tool. Prospective students can browse through the range of degree programmes to make their choice, apply for a programme and stay informed about their application and admission status.
- In the Student Management application, the students' data is managed from the very beginning of their studies until their final graduation.
- All courses can be planned, created and edited in the Courses area.
- The Exam Management application contains the exam registration system as well as students' results and allows managing academic progress and degrees.

 Alumni matters beyond the graduation of students can be organised in the alumni database of CAMPUSonline.

Additional Features

When it comes to research, CAMPUSonline offers an application for performance recording as well as a flexible tool for mapping all kinds of form-based processes. These features facilitate the process of applying for research projects or displaying results and awards granted for research achievements.

Two further features of CAMPUSonline cover university administration and customer relationship management (CRM). While the former allows you to display any form-based university processes such as leave requests or thesis applications, the latter can be used to organise all contacts in a specific contact database.


