- INITIAL MEETING -

- Confidential
- Anonymous upon request
- The initial meeting offers a safe space where you can share what has happened, sort out your thoughts, and we can consider possible courses of action together.

This can lead to various further steps, but does not have to!

INTERVENTIONS BY THE AKG -

- Counselling and advice
 e.g. with second party, with the supervisors of either party, with other relevant persons, ...
- Jointly consider further possibilities for action and support.
- If necessary, file a complaint with the Arbitration Board, file an application requesting an expert opinion with the Federal Equal Treatment Commission, file a disciplinary complaint, etc.

NO INTERVENTIONS BY THE AKG AT THIS POINT IN TIME

- Further discussions and support are still possible.
- If necessary, referrals are made to other institutions on and off of the university campus.

PRINCIPLES OF THE AKG

We do not take any steps without the consent of the person concerned!

The AkG has a professional obligation to maintain confidentiality and makes decisions independently of other authorities.
